Subject: Change in Application for Absentee Ballots

The Michigan Court of Appeals has ruled that city and township clerks can no longer automatically mail absent voter *applications* before each election to voters age 60 and over or to voters who have special needs or circumstances.

As you may recall, before each election, we have mailed absent voter ballot application forms to such voters, and many of you have expressed appreciation for this service and have come to rely upon it.

Although we can no longer provide this service, **we can create a permanent absent voter application list, as of this date.**

If you would like to be placed on this list to receive an absent voter *application* prior to each election, please check "yes" below, sign and return it to this office. We will place your written request on file, and it will be considered an "open ended" absent voter application request.

If not, then please submit a written request for an absent voter ballot prior to each election for which you desire an absent voter ballot.

It is always our pleasure to serve you in the very important election process; and if you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.
