RULES FOR POLITICAL SIGNS

1. Single and two-family residential use, maximum size 6 square feet per face and a maximum height of 42 inches and not in the public right-of-way.
2. All other uses, two signs per parcel and limited to a maximum area of 32 square feet each with a maximum height of 8 feet, set back 10 feet from the front property line and cannot be placed on public property including the City right-of-way along streets.
3. Must be down within 14 days after election. (If there is a Primary Election, the candidates successful at the Primary Election may leave signs in place until 14 days after the General Election.)
4. Property owner is responsible for removal.
5. Non-illuminated freestanding, wall and window signs are permitted.
6. City has no authority on content. Political-Freedom of Speech. (Political signs include candidates, proposal or any other opinion on how to vote)
